TSU provides a safe and confidential space for youth to freely express, process, and release the trauma they have experienced and/or witnessed. We provide resources and activities in the community that provide safety and stability for them and the means to live free of abuse.

Why? Did you know...

- More than 1.5 million youth are affected by dating abuse or violence alone.
- 15.5 Million children in the U.S. witness domestic violence annually.
- 1 to 4 teens is harassed or abused through technology
- Over 46 million kids in the U.S.

 America's children will have been
 exposed to domestic violence.
